All animals must have current Rabies Vaccination, current Health Certificate and Negative B.V.D. Testing Certificate. These papers MUST be checked prior to unloading. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Competition is open to all. Multiple entries accepted
- No exhibitors shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any class where only one farm or family's animals are exhibited.
- Entries and fees must be received by the Beef Superintendents by Monday, July 9th
- Animals will be judged FRIDAY, July 20, 2012 at 3:00 pm.
- The entry fee will be 10% of first place premium. Each exhibitor MUST purchase an exhibitor ticket which is \$5.00. Helper tickets will be available. (See Rules and Regulations)
- Exhibitors, when entering, please state on entry blank the number of stalls desired.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair Monday, July 16th from noon through 8:00 pm, Tuesday, July 17th, from 8:00 am through noon, Wednesday, July 18th from 3:00 pm through 8:00 pm and Thursday, July 19th, from 10:00 am until noon. Animals are expected to stay through 8:00 pm, Saturday, July 21st. Please contact the superintendents with your estimated time of arrival to ensure that New York State veterinarians are available at the time of unloading. NO animals to be unloaded without veterinary inspection.
- **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until the capacity of the cattle area is obtained.**
- In cow and calf class, both animals have to be owned by the same exhibitor. Calf must be over 30 days old and may be shown in individual class.
- Registration certificates must be available for inspection and must show ownership 60 days prior to opening day of the fair.
- Group class of (3) animals must be owned by the same exhibitor and each exhibitor shall be limited to one entry per breed.
