Judge – undetermined at this time

All classes will be judged according to USEF rules. The judge's decision is final.

1. **ALL** riders must be wearing an **ASTM** helmet while on the fairgrounds, regardless of age. Failure to comply with the helmet rule will result in ejection from the show and violators will forfeit all entries paid plus any premiums earned.
2. Livestock should enter via gate #6 to unload. **AFTER UNLOADING VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED TO THE PARKING LOT. THERE WILL BE NO PARKING INSIDE THE FAIRGROUND'S GATES AT ANY TIME.** Parking regulations are strictly enforced. Failure to comply will result with vehicles being towed. The vehicle owner will be charged for the towing fee.
3. **ACCORDING TO NYS AG & MARKETS LAW ALL ANIMALS WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE PROOF OF COGGINS (2010-2011) AND PROOF OF RABIES VACCINE IN THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS but no less than 14 days prior to the start of the horse show. PLEASE DO NOT BRING ORIGINALS. NO COPIES WILL BE MADE AT THE SHOW.**
4. All jumping courses will be posted in the barns near main doorways, at the announcer's stand and at the arena entry gate.
5. Open schooling will be available during posted times and at no other time unless advertised by the management. Horses needing additional schooling may use the warm up division.
6. Braiding is not required for this show.
7. Ponies may be asked to stand for measurement if animal's height is in question.
8. Once division has started, classes may be scratched, but **NO refunds** given.
9. The Hemlock Fair Association, show management and show staff assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage to horses, exhibitors or equipment from cause, and upon this condition only, will entries be accepted. Fall of horse or rider will constitute medical sign off before continued showing.
10. Paybacks will be awarded in all classes with 7 or more entries and will be paid as follows: \$10, \$8, \$6, \$4, \$2. All paybacks will be paid by check in the mail. Paybacks cannot be deducted from entry fees. A champion prize will be awarded in each division and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Participants are encouraged to enter full divisions to be considered for Hi-point. Ties for Hi-point will be broken by performance in the **HUS** class in respective division.
NOTE: Management reserves the right to combine classes with less than 3 entries.
NOTE: Each animal will receive one exhibitor's pass at no additional fee once entries are paid.

11. **FEES** **Classes** - \$10.00 per class. **NOTE:** Entry fees may be paid with an **open** signed check made payable to Hemlock Fair with exhibitor's # in the memo. Please read all requirements for divisions carefully when making entries.
Stalls - \$15.00 per stall. **NOTE: NO stall fee will be charged** for horses entered in a full division with entry fees paid.

Warm-Up Division

Open to all riders and horses. To be judged on performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences. Fence height 18"

Green Hunter Division

Open to all horses in the first or second year of showing. To be judged on performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2 feet.

Children's Pony Division

Open to riders 19 years old and under as of January 1, 2011. To be judged on performance of the PONY at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2 feet. Riders may cross enter. PONIES NOT TO EXCEED 14.2 HANDS. Ponies may be asked to provide proof of height.

Open Hunters Division

Open to all horses and riders. To be judged on performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'9".

Younger Children's Division

Open to riders 14 years old and under as of January 1, 2011. To be judged on performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2 feet 3 inches. Riders may cross enter.

Older Children's Division

Open to all riders 15-19 years old as of January 1, 2011. To be judged on performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2 feet 6 inches.

Riders may cross enter.

SCHOOLING BREAK

Short Stirrup Division

Open to all riders and horses. To be judged on performance of the horse or rider at a walk, trot and canter over cross rails. Can trot or canter first fence of each line. Simple lead changes are allowed. Riders in this division may NOT cross enter.

Academy Division

Open ONLY to lesson horses and riders. Horses used in this division may not be owned by the rider. To be judged on performance of the horse or rider at a walk, trot and canter over cross rails. Can trot or canter first fence of each line. Simple lead changes are allowed.

Walk/Trot Division

Open to riders under 14 years of age as of January 1, 2011. Riders in this division may NOT cross enter into any other division at this show. To be judged on performance of horse or rider at a walk, trot over cross rails.
